

# Draw an Arctic Fox

## Step by Step




1. To start, draw an oval for the head.




2. Next, draw a larger oval for the body.



3. Draw the front legs.



4. Draw the back leg on the left side. Because of the way this fox is sitting, you can't see the other back leg.




5. Draw the tail on the left side. An arctic fox's tail is big and bush and round on the end. You can also draw a small line between the front legs to show the part of the tail you can see behind the fox.



6. Draw the ears. The ears look like triangles, but they aren't pointy on the top. Make the top of the ears curved. Notice there is not a lot of space between the ears.




7. To draw the face, start with some guidelines. Draw a horizontal line straight across the middle of the head. Draw a vertical line down the middle of the head. Draw these lines very lightly -- you will be erasing them soon.



8. Draw the nose on the vertical line near the bottom of the face. Draw the eyes on the vertical line.



9. Now erase the guidelines.



10. Time to start with the details! Draw the fox's muzzle using curved lines from the eyes to the bottom of the nose.



11. Erase the extra lines for the head. Now your fox should look something like this:



12. Add the fur. Because the fox is white, you don't need to add much. The more fur you add, the darker it will look. Draw the fur as short or long lines in the direction the fur would naturally fall.



13. Add the pupils to the eyes. Remember to leave a small white spot in each eye. This spot is called the catchlight, and it's where the light is reflecting off of the eye.



10. Color in the nose and the darker parts of the inside of the ears. Add a little more black around the eyes. For a final touch, put a few lines on the ground for snow!
